Curriculum Connection:

Health and Safety:

This lesson focuses on **fire safety awareness, prevention, and emergency procedures.**

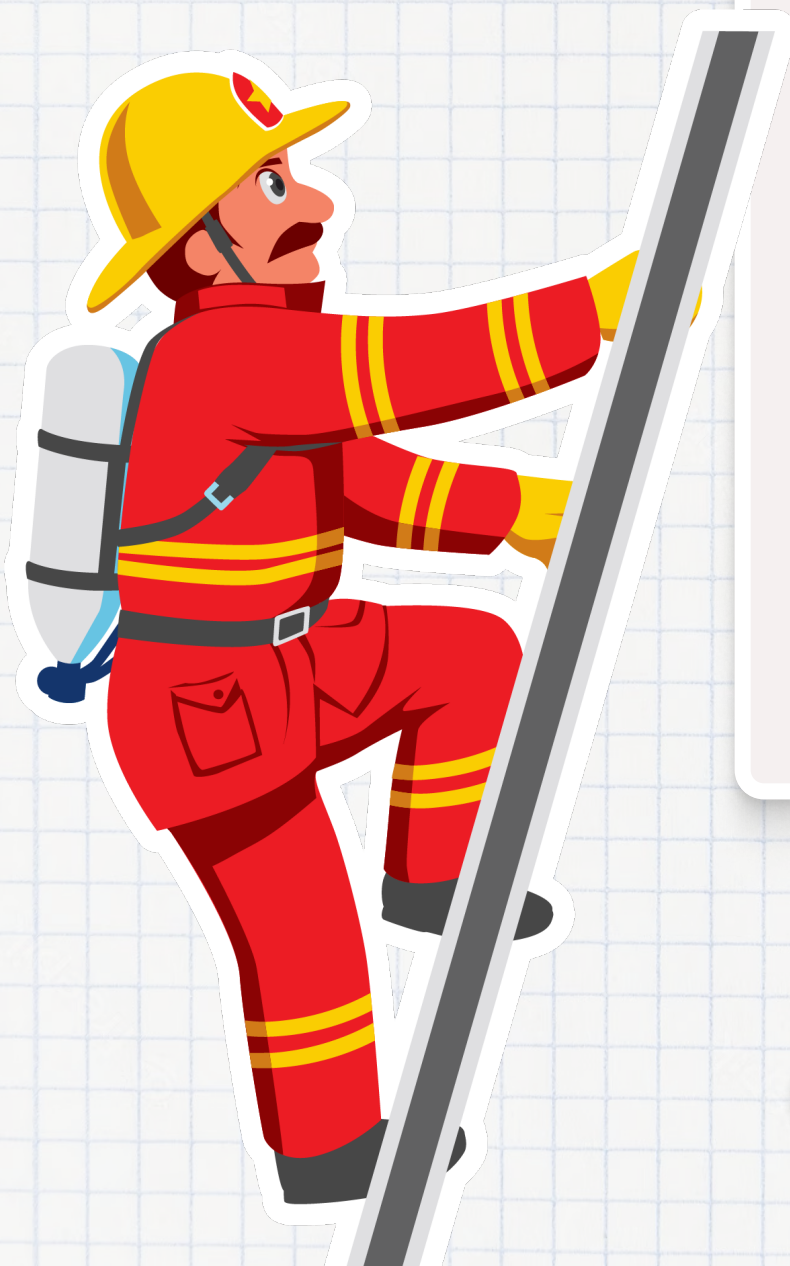
Learning Goals:

Health and Safety:

- Students will understand the importance of fire safety and be able to identify potential fire hazards in different parts of a house.
- Students will learn essential fire safety practices, including what to do in case of a fire and how to safely evacuate a building.

Language Arts:

- Students will actively engage in discussions about fire safety concepts, expressing their thoughts and ideas clearly.
- Students will listen attentively to the episode and participate in class conversations, enhancing their listening and comprehension skills.
- Students will practice writing by copying potential fire hazards from the board onto their Fire Hazards handouts.
- Students will create informative captions for their fire safety posters, demonstrating their ability to convey important information through written language.

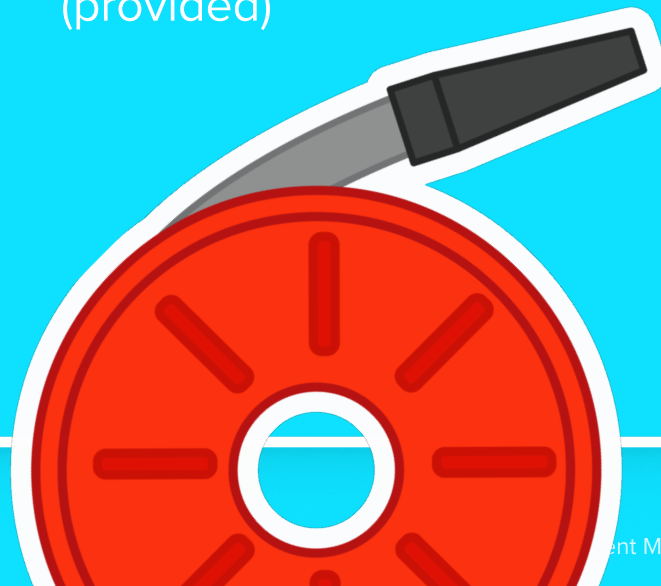

Lesson:



Introduction

Begin the lesson by discussing the importance of fire safety and why it's crucial to be aware of potential fire hazards and emergency procedures. Explain to students that they will watch an episode of Meekah and Blippi visiting the Fire Safety Learning Centre at the New York City Fire Museum where they will be speaking with Firefighter Harriet and Firefighter Tom.

Viewing the Episode:

Play the "Meekah & Blippi Learn Fire Safety" episode. Encourage students to pay close attention to the fire hazards in each room of the house and what to do in case of a fire.

Identifying Fire Hazards and Emergency Procedures:

After watching the episode, work on the Fire Hazards worksheet (provided) as a class. Write the different parts of the house (Kitchen, Living Room, Bedroom) on the board and ask students to share potential fire hazards for each area. Record shared answers on the board, and have students copy them onto their own Fire Hazards handout.

Mock Fire Drill:

Explain the importance of practicing what to do in case of a fire. Conduct a mock fire drill following school protocols. Have students practice "Get Low and Go" by crawling under imaginary smoke.

Demonstrate using the back of your hand to feel a door's temperature before opening it.

Extension:

Students can work in pairs to create a "Fire Safety Poster" (provided) that includes key fire safety tips, potential hazards, and emergency procedures. These posters can be displayed in the classroom or around the school to promote fire safety awareness among peers and the wider school community.

Assessment

Assess students' comprehension of fire safety principles through class discussions, their ability to identify fire hazards while completing Fire Hazards worksheet, and their participation in the mock fire drill.
