Lesson:

Introduction:

Gather students in a circle and discuss the concept of Earth Day, its significance, and why it is important to take care of the environment. Introduce the Blippi Wonders: Earth Day Song episode available on Kidoodle.TV. Explain that we will watch this episode to learn more about Earth Day and how we can help the environment.

Viewing the episode:

Play the Blippi Wonders: Earth Day Song for the students. Encourage active engagement by asking questions during the video for to check for comprehension and to promote critical thinking.

Questions for Discussion:

- What is Earth Day, and why do we celebrate it?
- What are some of the things in the video that we can do to help the Earth?
- How does Blippi show us ways to take care of the environment in the video?
- What are some examples of recycling?
- How can we save water, as mentioned in the video?
- What do you think would happen if we didn't take care of the Earth?

Discussion:

Lead a discussion based on the episode, focusing on key concepts such as the importance of Earth Day, actions we can take to help the environment, and how the students can contribute.

Activity Stations:

Craft Station: Making Birdhouses Milk Cartons

Guide students through the process of making birdhouses using milk crates. Encourage creativity and fine motor skills development as they paint, decorate, and assemble their birdhouses. Discuss the importance of providing shelter for birds and how it contributes to the ecosystem.

Planting Station:

Provide materials for students to plant seeds or small plants. Discuss the significance of plants and trees for the environment and guide students in planting activities.

Recycling Station:

Introduce different recyclable materials and guide students in sorting them into the correct bins. Discuss the importance of recycling and how it helps protect the Earth.

Assessment

Assess students' understanding of Earth Day and environmental conservation through observation and discussion:

- Did students actively engage in the video viewing and participate in discussions?
